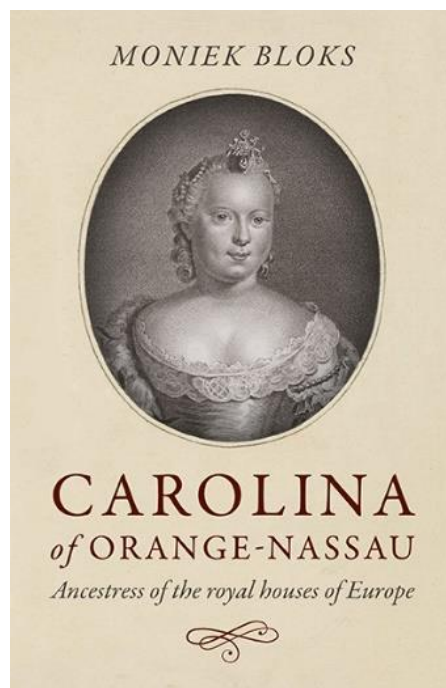




HISTORY OF ROYAL WOMEN is a popular blog focusing on royal women from every era with high quality articles.
